Sylvain's Tips

FOGGED MASK.

How many of you missed a nice dive because of a fogged mask ?! Here are some tips to avoid it in your next dives.



When you purchase a new mask, there is always a fine transparent coating covering the inside windows. (Coating, you say??!) . At the manufacturer, this coat is put on to protect the glass. To remove it, rub the window with a non abrasive toothpaste, let it dry and rinse thoroughly.

Before diving, it is recommended to keep your mask dry for a better preparation. On the market, there are some special products created to avoid fog in the mask.

- 1- Put a thin coat of the product on the inside glass and let it dry.
- 2- You may find on certain diving boats a mix of water and soap in a spray bottle. This mix is good as well. Just spray some of the mix on the dry inner glass.
- 3- There is always the old fashion; spit in the mask. Make sure your mask is dry before doing it. Do it as you want, spit in it or apply it

with your fingers, rub the inner glass thoroughly. The result will be the same. **IMPORTANT :** For each of the suggested solutions, **let your mask dry and rinse it only when you are ready to place it in front of your eyes and jump into the water.**

Have a good dive with a clear mask!
